Dear Parent/Guardian,

The St Dominic's College Athletics Carnival will be held on Friday 26th July at Parker St Field, Lemongrove. **The Carnival is a compulsory school activity and participation on the day is expected.** Students who are absent from the Carnival will be required to provide a note from parents/ guardians explaining their absence. Consequences will be in place for unexplained absences. Novelty events have been organised to run alongside championship events to allow participation by all students.

Getting There:

Students are to make their own way to Parker St Fields by 8:30am. Normal buses will run in the morning and afternoon from the College. The Carnival will conclude at approximately 2:45pm to allow time to return to College for buses. **Senior students are not permitted drive to Parker St.** Students who drive to school must park at the College and walk to the Carnival.

1500m Competitors:

Optional 1500m races will commence at 7:45am. Any student competing in a 1500m event must be at the Carnival by 7:30am.

Uniform:

Students are required to wear their full College Sports Uniform. Senior students may dress up in a costume which reflect their house colour. This costume can only be worn while they are at the Carnival. At the conclusion of the day, students must change back into their full College Sports Uniform. Costumes must be appropriate and not offensive in any way. Students from Y7 – Y10 are expected to change into their respective House shirt.

Timeline:

7:45am – 1500m events (optional)
8:30am – Homeroom (middle of Athletics Track)
8:45am – Events commence
2:45pm – Carnival conclusion

Leaving the Carnival:

It is expected that all students remain at the Carnival for the whole day. Should an emergency arise, and students need to be picked up before 2:45pm, students and parents will need to meet with their Pastoral Coordinator to obtain permission to leave early from the venue.

Track and Field Events Registration:

Students who would like to compete in track and field events are reminded that they are required to register via Canvas on the College or Sport Announcement Pages prior to the carnival.

Cancellation:

A decision will be made by 7am Friday morning if the Carnival has been postponed. This information will be posted on Canvas, the College newsfeed and social media pages. In the event of postponement, the students will need to attend school and have their books for lessons for Day 5 timetabled classes.

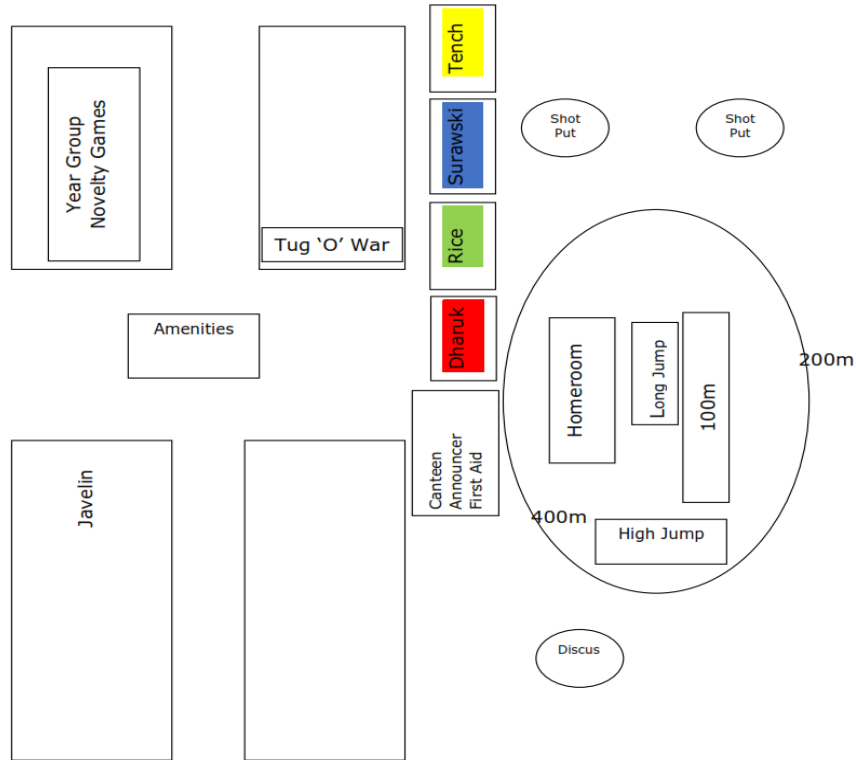
Students are not to bring valuables as bags may be unattended throughout the day. The College can be contacted on 4731 1933 if the need should arise.
